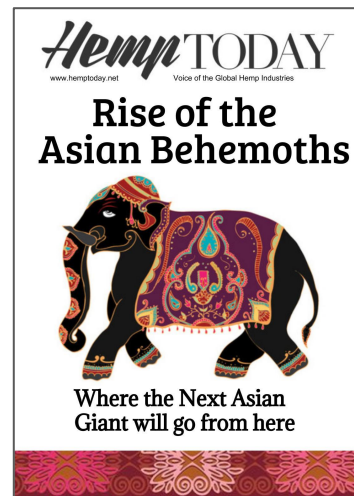

Early entrants poised to cash in on newly opened market

After years of struggle and disappointment, hemp industry stakeholders in Australia are finally seeing what they wanted all along: Legal hemp food products.

With regulatory approval that came only in 2017, Australian producers have gained access to a market estimated at \$13 million in potential seed and straw production. Estimates further indicate that demand for Australian grown hemp could quadruple over the next five years – with most of that coming from firms who are based in the industry only in the states of New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland and Tasmania.

Expansion of the hemp food and CBD sectors could be a significant contributor to a country's gross value added.

Along with seed, the battle to get hemp food products on the market in Australia dates to 2012. Since that time, more farmers in both countries are now able to legally produce and sell products containing up to 0.3% of THC, and much from the hemp seed has been legal for human consumption since October 2017.

Ministers from various states and territories in the process of amending their laws to make it clear a path for the industry and set out an regulatory framework and marketing strategy for hemp.

"This decision will also contribute significantly toward more sustainable farming in Australia," said Peter Williams, CEO of the Australian Hemp & CBD Association. 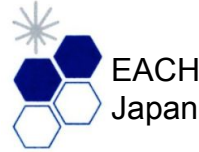
